



2010 SUMMER SESSION PAYMENT POLICY

Adult Open League Pricing:

- \$155 per skater if your roster size is 8 or 9 players
- \$175 per skater if your roster size is 7 players
- \$200 per skater if your roster size 6 players
- \$125 per skater if your roster size is 10 or more players

Youth Open League Pricing:

- \$165 per skater if your roster size is 8 or 9 players
- \$190 per skater if your roster size is 7 players
- \$220 per skater if your roster size 6 players
- \$130 per skater if your roster size is 10 or more players

Goalie Pricing:

Goalies are required to purchase a season's pass for \$100 which entitles them to play on as many teams as they wish in that division. (no multiple team discounts for goalies)

Deposit Policy:

\$100 plus current USA Hockey Membership (\$30 per player) dues must be paid by each skater prior to participation in his/her first game of the season. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.**

Roster Sizes & Final Payments:

Rosters sizes must be set after the third game and before the fourth. BALANCES based upon the applicable roster size will be due **PRIOR TO THE FOURTH GAME**. Any player who is not fully paid on or before the fourth game will be removed from Power Play until fully paid. Any player not in attendance for the Fourth game still needs to be paid in full by that game. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.**

Second Team Discount Policy:

All BWRHL members are entitled to participate on a second team for 20% off of the normal price. This discount will be applied as the last 20% due and cannot be used as a deposit or partial deposit. If a team is already receiving a discount for some other reason then the 2nd team discount cannot be applied to that team.

The purpose of these policies are many including:

- Fairness to the majority of BWRHL members who pay their fees when due.
- To encourage team captains to recruit a full roster without overly punishing them for coming up short.
- To gain clarity on exactly what each player owes;
- To provide several weeks of financing to players and at the same time creating a date certain for final payment for the BWRHL; and
- Most importantly, to take BWRHL employees out of the role of collectors and back into the role of league managers and directors.
